Liverpool Quaker Meeting act as data controller when we collect personal data from our customers, prospective customers, staff and other stakeholders for room hire and website enquiries.

How we collect data

Liverpool Quaker Meeting House collects personal data through:

- Enquiry web forms
- Booking enquiry emails
- Booking enquiry telephone calls/calls in person
- Job application forms
- Feedback Forms/Surveys

We will ensure that all personal information supplied is held in accordance with EU General Data Protection Regulation and UK Data Protection legislation.

Why we collect data

We collect this data in the legitimate interests of supporting our work, and for data collection for the performance of a contract where appropriate in order to arrange bookings and to offer services and events to our customers. We also use the data collected to carry out administrative and finance work.

Processing and consent

We will not use personal data for other purposes than your enquiry/contract without asking your permission. We will not keep this information for longer than necessary. We will not use third parties to process your data without taking reasonable steps to ensure they comply with UK Data Protection legislation and EU General Data Protection Regulation.

We will never sell your data to third parties.

Data location and security

Personal data is collected and stored securely subject to appropriate security measures and is protected against misuse.

Your personal data is held in electronic form and currently details of bookings are held in a paper based booking diary. Electronic data is held on secure servers, and in some

circumstances, on servers owned by third-party contractors. We ensure that any third party contractors we use comply with the UK Data Protection legislation and EU General Data Protection Regulations. We do not transfer your data outside the EEA. Data in paper form is held as securely as possible and destroyed securely where appropriate.

Social media

If you share our content through social media, for example by liking us on Facebook, following or tweeting about us on Twitter, those social networks will record that you have done so. They may set a cookie for this purpose.

As is the case for all cookies, we cannot access those set by social networks. Social networks cannot access cookies we set ourselves.

Log files

Our systems may automatically gather some anonymous information about visitors, including IP addresses, browser type, language, and the times and dates of webpage visits. The data collected does not include personally identifiable information. It is used, as described above, for statistical analysis, to understand user behaviour, and to administer the site.

Google Analytics

Our website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). The information generated by the cookie about your use of our website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of our website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf.
